In accordance with the requirements of paragraph 3 of Schedule 17 to the High Speed Rail (London - West Midlands) Act 2017, the nominated undertaker hereby requests approval of PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS relating to the following development authorised by the Act. Wendover Green Tunnel (Part of), Wendover Green Tunnel North Portal Building, B4009 Nash Lee Road Overbridge, Footpath ELL/20 Overbridge and associated retaining walls, Earthworks associated with Wendover Green Tunnel (Part of), Wendover North Cutting, Stoke Mandeville South Embankment (Part of), Earthworks associated with WEN/55/1 and accommodation access realignment, Earthworks associated with the realigned B4009 Nash Lee Road, Earthworks associated with the realigned Footpath ELL/20, Earthworks associated with the access to Wendover Green Tunnel North Portal Building and Compound (Access 1), Earthworks associated with the access from the realigned B4009 Nash Lee Road to Nash Lee Lane and Stoke Grove Auto Transformer Station (ATS) Compound and maintenance loop (Access 2), Earthworks associated with an accommodation access road from the realigned B4009 Nash Lee Road (Access 3), Earthworks associated with the access track to drainage ponds 13 and 14 from the realigned B4009 Nash Lee Road (Access 4), Diversion of Stoke Brook, Nash Lee Orchard Culvert, Grove Farm Culvert, 15 No. Drainage ponds, Drainage Ditches, Location of the permanent (security) fencing, and location of the vehicle restraint barriers

**P22/061** The application is on the Buckinghamshire Planning Portal but comments cannot be made as it has been removed or restricted from public viewing. The Clerk of Planning has made the Planning Committee aware. On 22<sup>nd</sup> August a letter was received from the Principal Planner for HS2 at Buckinghamshire Council stating that the letter is for information purposes only and the Council is not inviting comments in relation to this submission due to the Council's constrained powers under the Act.

Pedestrians Right of Way through HS2 workings in the Chilterns AONB

**P22/062** A Councillor from Lee Parish Councill advised that temporary footpath signs have been put up where footpaths leave Kings Lane, (Hunts Green / Kings Ash) in the direction of the A413, and also where WEN/10 leaves Rocky Lane and where WEN/33 arrives at Bowood Lane. Other signage in the Durham Farm area is adequate.
